## RULES

1. Prize money - Rule 76.6 applies if there are insufficient starters.
2. Rule 82.21 applies – ‘No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury’
3. Entry fees will be £12 per class except Classes 1 and 8 – these will be £8 per class. There is a mandatory charge of £2 per rider for First Aid. Cheques to be made payable to the IW BSJA.
4. Please note if the class section is not specified on the entry form, it will be assumed the horse/pony is competing in the Novice / Discovery / Newcomers or Foxhunter section of the class.
5. The committee (Area 43A) and the landowner accept no liability for an occurrence on the show site. Competitors and their supporters and friends are asked to have regard to the health and safety of others.
6. Horses tied to lorries must not be left unattended. Rubbish must be removed - no mucking out of lorries on the show site.
7. All competitors/riders must wear appropriate attire when mounted including fastened hat to BSEN 1384 standard (minimum).
8. The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall, or anybody who suffers an injury whilst on a showground, to report the fall/injury to the Show Secretary.
9. No unsupervised children allowed in the collecting area or warm-up ring.

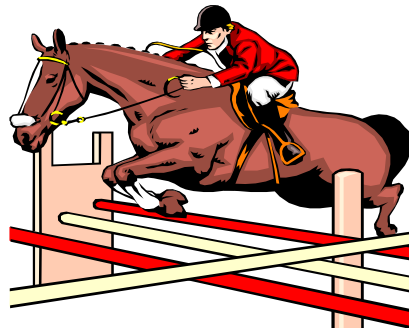
